City Life Small Group Leader: Tri-City

Description: A City Life Small Group Leader will be responsible for leading family meal time and small group time with 4-8 students during the underground teen center programming. Small group leaders will have YFC curriculum provided to you.

Purpose of Role: The Tri-City City Life Ministry is looking for individuals who will serve in The Underground Teen Center by leading groups of 4-8 students through YFC small group curriculum, centered around a Biblical topic, the Gospel itself, or a relevant life issue. Based on the life and ministry of Jesus with His disciples, we believe that these small group break out times are an essential part of spiritual development for our young people. Small Group Leaders will also join their students during family meal time, where students enjoy a meal and practice table manners.

Pre-requisites:

- A passion for the mission of campus life; to reach youth in Siouxland and provide a Christcentered, one on one relationship to each youth
- Willing to be onboarded and pass a background check
- Ability to commit time on a weekly basis (unless otherwise specified by site director)
- Desire to work with young people in a small group setting
- Structured ability to facilitate these groups each week

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Foster relationships with students in the group
- Use YFC curriculum to lead group (unless otherwise directed)
- Commit to praying for students in the group
- Other duties specifically assigned

Time Commitment: Flexible depending on your schedule. 2-4 hours/week
