



Community Engagement Team Member: Sioux County

Description: The Community Engagement Team is a temporary team to help guide the See The Story, Be The Story process. Duties for team members include but are not limited to: personally inviting guests, attending 50 minute STS events, distributing invitations, serving as a table host at the 1 hour BTS ask event, follow up phone calls, and assisting with the event planning process.

Purpose of Role: To assist in the See The Story (STS) and Be The Story (BTS) event process. The purpose of the STS / BTS event process is to find like minded people to become both financial and human resources to support current and future YFC community ministry sites in our pursuit of reaching lost teens and introducing them to Jesus. Having a team of people connecting us to like minded people in the community is paramount to reaching more kids, which is the role of the Community Engagement Team.

Pre-requisites:

- A passion for the mission of Siouxland YFC
- Ability to understand and communicate the mission of YFC
- Enjoy networking with others
- Excellent communication skills
- Strong personable and relational skills

Roles & Responsibilities:

1. Attending See The Story 50 minute programs
2. Personally inviting guests
3. Distributing invitations
4. Serving as a table host at the one-hour Be The Story event
5. Follow up phone calls with your connections
6. Other assistance for event as needed

Time Commitment: Average 2-5 hours a month, up to 6 month commitment. Including four training sessions, STS events + follow up calls, and 1 BTS event.
