## City Life Kitchen Cook: Sioux County

**Description:** A City Life Family Meal Time Cook will be responsible for the prep and cooking of the meal for 20-40 youth and volunteers. Food will be purchased before hand and a full kitchen and resources available.

**Purpose of Role:** The Hawarden Teen Center is looking for individuals who will serve in our location by preparing the meals for YFC staff, volunteers, and youth at our Thursday evening City Life programming. Providing meals for these young people is important, as some do not have meals available at home. During this family meal time, young people learn table manners and eat dinner as a family, something that is often new to many of them.

### **Pre-requisites:**

- A passion for the mission of Siouxland Youth For Christ
- Basic cooking skills needed to prepare meals (use of oven, ability to follow recipes, measure, etc.)
- Ability to commit time on a weekly basis (unless otherwise specified by site director)
- Desire to feed youth in the community

### **Roles & Responsibilities:**

1. Prepare food for about 20-40 people
2. Communicate with YFC staff for details on upcoming meals
3. Abide by safety and sanitation measures
4. Arrive to YFC building timely to prepare food on time (by 3:00 pm)
6. Other duties specifically assigned

**Time Commitment:** Flexible depending on your schedule. Once a week or on a monthly basis. 1-2 hours on Thursdays.
