Juvenile Justice Ministry Advocate

Description: An advocate in the Juvenile Justice Ministry program will be matched with a student in Juvenile Detention or other treatment facility to walk alongside them in a trusting, mentorship relationship. Advocates will act as positive Christ-centered role models for the students.

Purpose of Role: The Tri-City City Juvenile Justice Ministry is looking for individuals who will serve in our advocacy program. The advocacy program was named with the thought that Jesus was our first advocate. We want to connect trusting, Christian adults with young people who may not have that influence in their life. Our hope is that through a relationship with an advocate, these young people's lives would be changed and that they may come to know Jesus.

Pre-requisites:

- A passion for connecting with young people, specifically in juvenile detention, treatment facilities, or similar situations.
- Excitement to reach youth in the Juvenile Justice Ministry and provide a Christcentered, one on one relationship to each young person
- Willing to be onboarded and pass a background check
- Ability to commit time on a weekly basis for at least 1 year (unless otherwise specified by site director)
- Desire to make a difference in the lives of young people

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Foster relationships with a young person in the Juvenile Justice Ministry
- Ability to connect over the phone or in person
- Commit to praying for your match
- Other duties specifically assigned

Time Commitment: Flexible depending on your schedule. 1-2 hours/week with a minimum 1 year commitment
