

City Life Meal Donor: Sioux County

Description: A City Life Meal Donor will be responsible for purchasing and delivering (or scheduling delivery) a meal for 20-40 youth and volunteers. The meal must be prepared by a certified kitchen, so catering or delivery must be from a restaurant or other certified establishment or deliver groceries to be prepared in the Teen Center kitchen or other be pre-packed items (ex: pizza delivery, or pre-packaged sandwiches/bagged chips).

Purpose of Role: The Hawarden City Life Teen Center is looking for individuals who will serve in our location by donating meals for youth, staff, and volunteers at our Thursday evening programming. During this family meal time, young people learn table manners and eat dinner in a “family” group setting, many of which do not experience at home.

Pre-requisites:

- A passion for the mission of Siouxland Youth For Christ
- Ability to coordinate ahead with YFC staff
- Ability to have food ordered and delivered to YFC
- Desire to feed youth in the community
- Willingness to cover the financial costs of the meal

Roles & Responsibilities:

1. Purchase, order and have food delivered for about 20-40 people
2. Communicate with YFC staff for details on upcoming meals
3. Ability to financially cover the cost of the meal
4. Have food delivered YFC building timely to prepare food on time (by 5:00 pm)
5. Other duties specifically assigned

Time Commitment: Flexible depending on your schedule and willingness to donate (Thursday evenings)
